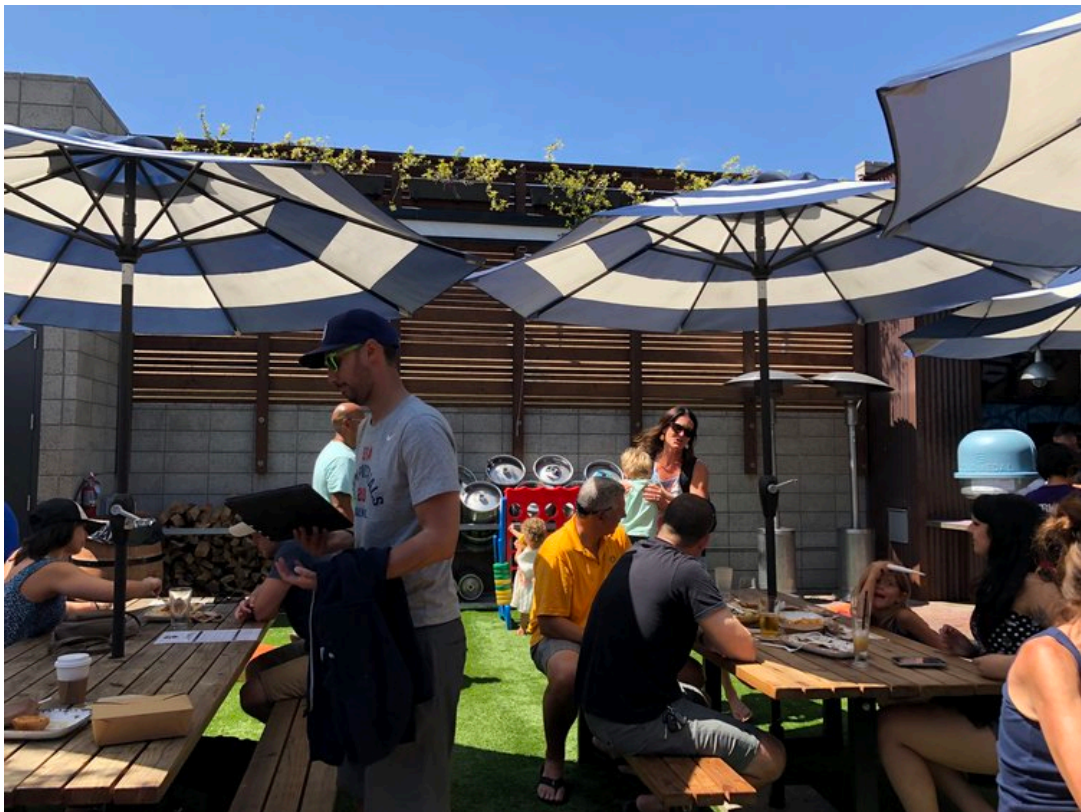
## **Park 101**
